

ADVENT JOY

Have you ever noticed that there's one pink candle in the Advent wreath? Three purple candles and one pink.

And the pink candle is always lit on the third week of Advent. If it was the first or last week, maybe that would mean something, but the third week???

The third week is a special week in Advent because we round a corner in this month-long observance. The first week is all about hope and expectations we look forward to being fulfilled. The second week is about peace, which still has an element of unfulfilled expectation. We can experience peace, but we still long for God's greater Shalom to fill our world. Now this third week we turn to joy. The wonderful thing about joy is that we can fully rejoice even while we're waiting on God's plan to unfold.

The Apostle Paul wrote the book of Philippians from a prison. We don't know if it was dank and wet, or if he had some freedom as prisoners sometimes had in the ancient world; nevertheless, his movement was limited, and he speaks of desiring to be free. Yet despite his imprisonment he gives a powerful command to all of us: Rejoice in the Lord always; and again I say rejoice!

Of all the books of the New Testament, Philippians has the most to say about rejoicing and being joyful. Paul's hope for freedom was, perhaps, only a dim light. His desire for a more peaceful situation was certainly deep. Yet in his present circumstance he finds every reason to rejoice. He rejoices that his imprisonment is helping him spread the Gospel message. He rejoices that whether he is delivered or not, Christ will be glorified. He rejoices that the shackles of his past life have been released, and now he lives only for Christ.

What are you joyful about this season? What is bringing a sense of new life to you? What hopes do you see being fulfilled in your life and the lives of your loved ones?

When Mary, the mother of Jesus, heard that she would bear God's son, we can only imagine how awesome and fearful that message must have been for her. But she too joins in the rejoicing, crying out, "My Soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior, for God has looked with favor on the lowliness of his servant. Surely, from now on all generations will call me blessed!"

Rejoice in the Lord always; and again I say rejoice!

As we draw near to "the big day", let our hearts be filled with joy, for God is already at work in the world. Whatever our circumstance, God is faithful to all generations of those who fear him!

So back to that pink candle—pink is a color of joy and celebration. It's a sign that something is indeed changing, and God's promises must be celebrated!
